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Breakthrough Enters Boston Public Schools' New Opportunity Portfolio

Boston Public Schools (BPS) launched the Boston Opportunity Portfolio this fall, a new and significant strategy to grow partnerships with exceptional programs, with the ultimate aim of increasing equitable access to quality learning opportunities in the city. Over 180 programs applied to be a part of the Portfolio, and we are pleased to be one of sixty programs recognized for our college access work in Boston. Breakthrough has also been admitted to the 5th Quarter Portfolio, an additional strategy for identifying and increasing equitable access to quality summer learning opportunities for BPS students.

BPS used a comprehensive vetting and assessment process to identify exceptional organizations that collaborate with BPS, factoring in organizational quality, organizational health, and the quality of the relationship with schools and staff. In addition, BPS selected Breakthrough because of our proven results in guiding students along the path to college, and our commitment to equitable practices throughout the program.

Now that BPS has identified Opportunity Portfolio programs, BPS will strategically support these programs. Portfolio programs will be eligible for additional funding and will gain additional access to BPS facilities and resources. BPS will promote Portfolio programs to schools, students, and families, and offer information sharing and professional development opportunities to partners. Breakthrough is thrilled to continue deepening our partnership with the Boston Public Schools.

Partners Create Student Experiences

Breakthrough students participated in a number of new creative and career-exposure experiences this fall thanks to SAP, Boston Pulse, and Novartis!

At the SAP Social Innovation Series, BTGB students attended an innovation workshop where students proposed ways to promote health and wellness within their school. Anaya, Alia, Anisa, and Lamisa pitched the winning idea of promoting more physical movement through convertible desks in classrooms, winning a \$1,000 grant.

Thanks to Boston Pulse, interested BTGB students joined a poetry class held after school at Breakthrough throughout the fall, where students wrote and performed poems about their life experiences.

Students also attended a Lab Bootcamp series at Novartis, where they conducted an experiment to identify patients for a hypothetical clinical trial of a new asthma mediation with the help of professional chemists at Novartis's laboratories.
